

Our organisation has recently undergone a very thorough and time-consuming audit with the

Australian Aged Care Quality Agency. We are happy to say that the final audit report showed that **we met all 18 of the 18 required outcomes**. This is a wonderful result! Thankyou to clients, volunteers, staff and board members who took time to speak with the two officers who conducted the audit over a very intense 8 hours. Meanwhile, all our services continued as usual on this challenging day!

Flexible Care Services is an incorporated community not-for-profit organisation. It has its own constitution which members are free to peruse or obtain a copy. We have sought and obtained the following benefits:
