

INTERVIEW WITH JENNY JAMES

What is your role at Flexible Care Services? I am the Care Manager for our care workers Pru Pavitt, Wendy Chesworth, Kay Wyatt and Liz Butt. I also am involved with social support, organising our "roving lunches" twice a month so clients can get out of the house and enjoy socialising with others.

What else do you do? Well, the most important thing is to do assessments for clients that have personal care and respite needs. That involves looking at the level of personal care required, checking health and safety in the home, seeing if any special equipment is needed and giving advice to help folk live independently where they can. I also organise the rosters for our care workers, monitor any concerns and liaise with other agencies so our clients can get the best possible care.

What does personal care involve? It means our care workers visit clients up to 7 days per week, assisting them to shower, dress, put on support stockings if needed and check on their wellbeing. We also know that carers – often a husband or wife – sometimes need a break, so we provide short-term relief so they can do just that!



What motivates you with your work?

Enjoyment! I like helping people. It is very satisfying and families often express their thanks. It is an important service to keep going. Being local makes it easier for me to establish a rapport and trust

with those we help who are generally vulnerable elderly people.

Postscript......Jenny was with Flexible Care at the beginning, working with Pat Thurkettle. She started as a personal carer in the late 1990s and

has worked continuously apart from a few short breaks.
