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#### **BOARD NEWS**

Flexible Care continues to be a busy, dynamic and forward-looking organisation always with improvement in mind.

On some staffing matters, we wish to extend sincere sympathy to our Community Transport Coordinator Trish Shea on the passing of John. It is a very sad time for Trish, her family and friends. John's involvement in the local community was huge and he will be greatly missed.

You will be aware that our CEO Debby Glover will be retiring in April. As I write, the Board is preparing to interview candidates for this crucial position at Flexible Care. Debby continues to throw herself into the job and has generously agreed to stay on for a "hand over period" to ensure a smooth transition for the new CEO.

The Hub (our new social room within our premises) is undergoing a makeover. A false wall has been taken out, windows exposed and cleaned to ensure natural light and ventilation - it will make a huge difference. Thankyou to builder Garry White for an excellent job here! We will be investigating the possibility of having a disabled toilet close to the Hub for the convenience of clients but this may be some time into the future.

CEO Debby Glover and Board Director Jan Ryan met (via Zoom) with the transport manager for TransportNSW to discuss key performance indicators (KPIs). We received a very good report for the wonderful service we provide.

Flexible Care has now subscribed to an organisation called AFEI (Australian Federation of Employers & Industries) to keep up to date with changing legislation and industrial matters pertinent to the social services sector. This is very important to ensure our organisation keeps our head above water with such matters.

Although COVID restrictions appear to be easing at present, we are very mindful of health matters and keeping everyone safe - staff, volunteers and clients. You can be assured that Flexible Care will take every precaution to minimise health risks whilst continuing to provide our usual excellent services.

Finally, at a Special General Meeting last month, our constitution (available for anyone to see) was updated. As a result, you can now become a Life Member of Flexible Care for \$30.
